India is committed to sharing its population-scale experiences in delivering healthcare services with countries of the Global South.

Effective and responsive Trauma care systems are essential aspects of any national healthcare and emergency response system. The world-renown All Indian Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) at New Delhi through its JPN Apex Trauma Centre, operates one of the best examples of a tertiary care trauma centre.

With 8 state-of-the art dedicated trauma related clinical departments and infrastructure, this 260 bedded facility handles close to 60,000 trauma cases daily, and operates over 8000 critical trauma surgeries each year with high success rates. In recognition of its academic and public health significance, this facility is also a designated collaborating centre for WHO, apart from several domestic collaborations with India's National Disaster Management Authority.

This short stay (07 days) ITEC course on **EFFECTIVE TRAUMA CARE FOR 21ST CENTURY:THE AIIMS EXPERIENCE** provides health care professionals of countries from the Global South to travel to India and learn how to set up and operate trauma care departments and facilities to effectively handle mass casualty. The course, based on models and experiences developed at AIIMS, is well-aligned with WHO goals and provides the participant an immersive experience on the subject through extensive table top exercises, guided visits to centre facilities and exposure to real life hospital and community situations.

The course is also provides brief modules on leadership, communication and entrepreneurship to provide participants a holistic training experience.

OUTLINE OF COURSE

DAY 1	Module on Mass /Casualty Management/ zoning of hospitals, with Table Top Exercise on Hospital zoning
DAY 2	Module on process flows during mass casualty events/ roles to be taken/ incident commander system of AIIMS followed by Table top exercises
DAY 3	Guided visits to departments and Trauma Centre facilities Overview of Global Trauma care practice/ WHO frameworks
DAY 4	Modules at NIESBUD on leadership/communication skills/entrepreneurship LOCAL SIGHTSEEING
DAY 5	LOCAL SIGHTSEEING / PERSONAL TIME
DAY 6	Sessions on planning and design of trauma centre, IT systems, human resource management, medico-legal management and quality parameters
DAY 7	Sessions on trauma related finance and welfare schemes, good-samaritan practices, community engagement, organ donation and trauma registry CONCLUSION/VALEDICTORY

Note: All sessions (except those pertaining to day 4) will be held on-premises at AIIMS Apex Trauma Centre. Accommodation will be provided at NIESBUD, Noida, from where participants would be provided local transport each day.
