PRESIDENT OF INDIA HOSTS PRESIDENT OF RUSSIAN FEDERATION



The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu, received H.E. Mr Vladimir Putin, President of the Russian Federation, at Rashtrapati Bhavan (December 05, 2025). She also hosted a banquet in his honour. Welcoming President Putin and his delegation to Rashtrapati Bhavan, the President said that his visit marks an important milestone: the 25th anniversary of the India-Russia Strategic Partnership, which was established in October 2000 during his first visit to India as President.

The President also recalled the centuries old cultural dialogue between our people, from ancient trade routes, to the inspiring correspondence through letters between Mahatma Gandhi and Leo Tolstoy, and the mutual admiration for each other's rich cultural, literary and artistic heritage. Both leaders expressed confidence that the friendship between our two countries, which has been steadfast for many years, will continue to prosper for many more to come.

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed the India – Russia Business Forum with Russian President H.E. Mr. Vladimir Putin in Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. Presenting his remarks, the Prime Minister greeted His Excellency President Putin, leaders from India and abroad, and all distinguished guests, remarking that the India Russia Business Forum reflects a significant initiative by President Putin, who has brought a large delegation to participate in the event. He highlighted his heartfelt welcome to all attendees and expressed that being among them was a moment of great joy. Shri Modi conveyed deep gratitude to his friend President Putin for joining the forum and sharing his valuable thoughts.

PM Modi noted that, as mentioned by Union Minister, Shri Piyush Goyal and highlighted by President Putin regarding the possibilities ahead, India and Russia can achieve very ambitious targets in a short span of time. He remarked that whether in business or diplomacy, the foundation of any partnership is mutual trust, and emphasized that the greatest strength of India-Russia relations lies in this trust. He highlighted that this trust provides both direction and momentum to joint efforts and serves as the launch pad inspiring new dreams and aspirations. The Prime Minister recalled that last year President Putin and he had resolved to surpass the target of \$100 billion in bilateral trade by 2030, but observed that in his recent discussions with President Putin and given the visible potential, it is clear that waiting until 2030 will not be necessary.

PM chairs 50th meeting of PRAGATI



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi chaired the 50th meeting of PRAGATI - the ICT-enabled multi-modal platform for Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation - earlier today, marking a significant milestone in a decade-long journey of cooperative, outcome-driven governance under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. The milestone underscores how technology-enabled leadership, real-time monitoring and sustained Centre-State collaboration have translated national priorities into measurable outcomes on the ground.

During the meeting, Prime Minister reviewed five critical infrastructure projects across sectors, including Road, Railways, Power, Water Resources, and Coal. These projects span 5 States, with a cumulative cost of more than ₹40,000 crore.

During a review of PM SHRI scheme, Prime Minister emphasized that the PM SHRI scheme must become a national benchmark for holistic and future ready school education and said that implementation should be outcome oriented rather than infrastructure centric. He asked all the Chief Secretaries to closely monitor the PM SHRI scheme. He further emphasized that efforts must be made for making PM SHRI schools benchmark for other schools of state government. He also suggested that Senior officers of the government should undertake field visits to evaluate the performance of PM SHRI schools.

BlueBird Block-2 is a spacecraft of the USA and the heaviest satellite ever launched from Indian soil into its intended orbit. Prime Minister holds a telephone conversation with the Prime Minister of New Zealand



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi held a telephone conversation with the Prime Minister of New Zealand, The Rt. Hon. Christopher Luxon today. The two leaders jointly announced the successful conclusion of the historic, ambitious and mutually beneficial India–New Zealand Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

With negotiations having been Initiated during PM Luxon's visit to India in March 2025, the two leaders agreed that the conclusion of the FTA in a record time of 9 months reflects the shared ambition and political will to further deepen ties between the two countries. The FTA would significantly deepen bilateral economic engagement, enhance market access, promote investment flows, strengthen strategic cooperation between the two countries, and also open up new opportunities for innovators, entrepreneurs, farmers, MSMEs, students and youth of both countries across various sectors.

With the strong and credible foundation provided by the FTA, both leaders expressed confidence in doubling bilateral trade over the next five years as well as an investment of USD 20 billion in India from New Zealand over the next 15 years. The leaders also welcomed the progress achieved in other areas of bilateral cooperation such as sports, education, and people-to-people ties, and reaffirmed their commitment towards further strengthening of the India-New Zealand partnership.

Prime Minister attends India-Oman Business Forum



The Santhali language, which was included in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution through the 92nd Amendment Act, 2003, is one of the most ancient living languages of India. It is spoken by a significant number of tribal people in Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal and Bihar.
