PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI MEETS PRESIDENT ALEKSANDR LUKASHENKO AND PRESIDENT XI JINPING AT SCO





Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi met with Mr. Xi Jinping, President of the People's Republic of China, on the sidelines of the Summit of the leaders of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) in Tianjin on 31 August 2025.

Both leaders welcomed the positive momentum and steady progress in bilateral relations since their last meeting in Kazan in October 2024. They reaffirmed that the two countries were development partners and not rivals, and that their differences should not turn into disputes. A stable relationship and cooperation between India and China and their 2.8 billion peoples on the basis of mutual respect, mutual interest and mutual sensitivity are necessary for the growth and development of the two countries, as well as for a multipolar world and a multi-polar Asia befitting the trends of the 21st century. Belarusian President Lukashenko also exchanged warm greetings with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

ADDRESS TO THE NATION BY THE HON'BLE PRESIDENT OF INDIA SMT. DROUPADI MURMU ON THE EVE OF THE 79TH INDEPENDENCE DAY



President Droupadi Murmu addressed the nation on the eve of the 78th Independence Day. "Modi govt has taken numerous initiatives for welfare of SC, ST and marginalised sections. Social justice is the top priority of Modi govt," said President Murmu. The President also conferred gallantry and service medals to personnel from the police and other security and combat forces today, including a President's Medal for Gallantry (PMG) and 213 Medals for Gallantry (GM).

The President's Medal for Gallantry (PMG) has been awarded to Chaduvu Yadaiah, Head Constable of Telangana Police who despite severe injuries due to knife attacks managed to catch and hold on to the individuals involved in chain snatching and arms dealing in July 2022. As many as 94 personnel will be honoured with President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service (PSM) and 729 with Medal for Meritorious Service (MSM). PSM is awarded for special distinguished record in Service and MSM is awarded for valuable service characterised by resource and devotion to duty. These medals are announced twice a year, the other being on the occasion of Republic Day.

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's address on the 79th Independence Day of India







Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed the Nation on the 79th Independence Day from the ramparts of the Red Fort, Delhi on 15th August 2025. The address to the nation by Shri Modi was the longest and most decisive address from the Red Fort, lasting 103 minutes, charting a bold roadmap for a Viksit Bharat by 2047. Prime Minister's address focussed on self-reliance, innovation, and citizen empowerment, highlighting India's journey from a nation dependent on others to a globally confident, technologically advanced, and economically resilient country.

PM Modi outlined the vision for a Viksit Bharat 2047, emphasizing that India's progress is built on self-reliance, innovation, and citizen empowerment. He stated that across sectors ranging from strategic defence to semiconductors, clean energy to agriculture, and digital sovereignty to youth empowerment, the roadmap seeks to transform India into a \$10 trillion economy by 2047, making it globally competitive, socially inclusive, and strategically autonomous.

On the 79th Independence Day, PM Modi addressed the nation, highlighting India's journey of self-reliance and transformation. He said that over the past decade, India has been reforming, performing, and transforming, but now the time has come to move forward with even greater strength. He emphasized that the government is committed to creating a modern, efficient, and citizen-friendly ecosystem, where laws, regulations, and processes are simplified, entrepreneurship is encouraged, and every Indian can contribute to building a Viksit Bharat.

Simplifying Laws and Compliance

At the outset of his address, PM Modi said that over the past years, the government has undertaken a historic wave of reforms, abolishing over 40,000 unnecessary compliances and repealing more than 1,500 outdated laws. Dozens of other laws were simplified in Parliament, always keeping citizens' interests at the forefront.

In the recent session alone, over 280 provisions were removed, making governance simpler and more accessible for every Indian. PM Modi emphasized that reform is not just about economics, it is about transforming the everyday lives of citizens.

Among the key achievements, he highlighted:

Income Tax Reform and Faceless Assessment, making the system transparent and efficient

Zero tax for annual income up to ₹12 lakh, a benefit that many could not have imagined even a few years ago

Replacement of outdated criminal laws with the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, simplifying justice and legal procedures

These reforms signal a modern, citizen-centric government where ordinary people can experience ease, fairness, and empowerment. PM Modi underscored that India is committed to structural, regulatory, policy, process, and procedural reforms, building a nation where governance works for the people, not the other way around.

Empowering Entrepreneurs and MSMEs

The government's reforms aim to reduce compliance costs for startups, MSMEs, and entrepreneurs, while ensuring freedom from the fear of outdated legal provisions. This creates a more conducive environment for business growth, encouraging innovation and economic self-reliance.

Next-Generation Reforms and Task Force

PM Modi announced the formation of a Task Force for Next-Generation Reforms, which will evaluate all current laws, rules, and procedures related to economic activities. The Task Force will work within a set timeline to:

Reduce compliance costs for startups, MSMEs, and entrepreneurs

Provide freedom from fear of arbitrary legal actions

Ensure laws are streamlined for ease of doing business

These reforms are aimed at creating a supportive ecosystem for innovation, entrepreneurship, and economic growth.

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addresses the M.S. Swaminathan Centenary International Conference



Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated and addressed the M.S. Swaminathan Centenary International Conference at ICAR PUSA in New Delhi. Paying tribute to Professor M. S. Swaminathan, the Prime Minister described him as a visionary whose contributions transcend any single era. He added that Professor Swaminathan was a great scientist who transformed science into a medium of public service. Shri Modi highlighted that Professor Swaminathan dedicated his life to ensuring food security for the nation. Noting that Professor Swaminathan awakened a consciousness that will continue to guide India's policies and priorities for centuries to come. He extended his best wishes to all on the occasion of the Swaminathan Birth Centenary Celebrations.

The Prime Minister acknowledged the occasion of National Handloom Day and highlighted that in the past ten years, the handloom sector has gained new recognition and strength across the country. He extended his greetings to all, especially to those associated with the handloom sector, on National Handloom Day.

Sharing his association with Dr. M. S. Swaminathan spanned many years, PM Modi recalled the earlier conditions in Gujarat, where agriculture faced severe challenges due to droughts and cyclones. Noting that during his tenure as Chief Minister, work began on the Soil Health Card initiative, he remembered Professor Swaminathan showing great interest in the initiative, offering open-hearted suggestions that significantly contributed to its success. Shri Modi mentioned visiting Professor Swaminathan's Research Foundation Centre in Tamil Nadu nearly twenty years ago. He stated that in 2017, he had the opportunity to release Professor Swaminathan's book, 'The Quest for a World Without Hunger'. He added that in 2018, during the inauguration of the International Rice Research Institute's Regional Centre in Varanasi, Professor Swaminathan's guidance was invaluable.

Prime Minister emphasised the importance of maintaining peace and tranquillity on the border, and reiterated India's commitment to a fair, reasonable and mutually acceptable resolution of the boundary question.

Prime Minister welcomed the steady and positive progress in bilateral ties since his meeting with President Xi in Kazan last year, guided by mutual respect, mutual interest and mutual sensitivity, including the resumption of the Kailash Manasarovar Yatra.

Prime Minister thanked President Xi for the invitation to the SCO Summit and conveyed his acceptance. He expressed support for China's Presidency of the SCO Summit and said that he looked forward to meeting President Xi in Tianjin. PM underlined that stable, predictable, and constructive ties between India and China will contribute significantly to regional and global peace and prosperity.


