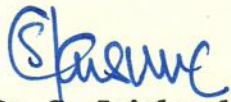

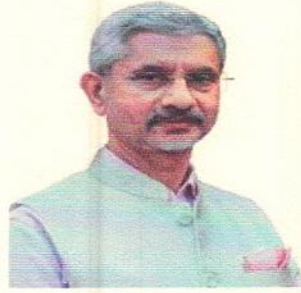

भारत तथा विदेशों में स्थित सभी पासपोर्ट जारी करने वाले प्राधिकरणों को 14वें पासपोर्ट सेवा दिवस के अवसर पर मेरी हार्दिक शुभकामनाएँ।

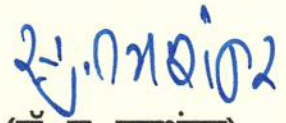
सार्वजनिक सेवाओं को एक निर्बाध डिजिटल पारिस्थितिकी तंत्र (ecosystem) में एकीकृत करने के हमारे प्रयासों ने नए आयाम स्थापित किए हैं। मुझे यह बताते हुए प्रसन्नता हो रही है कि गत वर्ष मंत्रालय ने देशभर में अपने व्यापक नेटवर्क में उन्नत पासपोर्ट सेवा कार्यक्रम (PSP V2.0) को सफलतापूर्वक लागू किया। इसके साथ ही, हमने विश्वभर में स्थित अपने राजनयिक मिशनों एवं केंद्रों में वैश्विक पासपोर्ट सेवा कार्यक्रम (GPSP V2.0) को लागू कर भारतीय प्रवासी समुदाय की सुरक्षा और सुविधा को और सुदृढ़ किया है। यह एकीकृत डिजिटल अवसंरचना सुनिश्चित करती है कि देश के भीतर के आवेदकों तथा विदेशों में रह रहे भारतीय नागरिकों, दोनों को अत्याधुनिक डिजिटल सेवाओं का लाभ प्राप्त हो।

इस तकनीकी परिवर्तन की एक महत्वपूर्ण उपलब्धि चिप-युक्त ई-पासपोर्ट का सफल क्रियान्वयन है। अंतरराष्ट्रीय मानकों के अनुरूप ये यात्रा दस्तावेज हमारे नागरिकों के लिए सुरक्षा और प्रमाणीकरण को और मजबूत बनाते हैं। डिजिटल जैसी प्रणालियों के साथ सुरक्षित एकीकरण तथा उन्नत प्रौद्योगिकियों के उपयोग से हम आवेदन प्रक्रिया को अधिक तीव्र, पारदर्शी और उपयोगकर्ता-अनुकूल बना रहे हैं।

हम 545 से अधिक पासपोर्ट सेवा केंद्रों (PSKs) और डाकघर पासपोर्ट सेवा केंद्रों (POPSKs) के व्यापक नेटवर्क के माध्यम से अपनी अवसंरचना का निरंतर विस्तार कर रहे हैं। पासपोर्ट मोबाइल वैन की तैनाती के साथ हम अंतिम छोर तक सेवा पहुँचाने की दिशा में सक्रिय रूप से कार्यरत हैं। इससे देश के दूरस्थ एवं ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों तक विश्वसनीय, लचीली और सुविधाजनक सेवाएँ पहुँच रही हैं। मुझे यह बताते हुए खुशी हो रही है कि वित्त वर्ष 2013-14 में जारी किए गए 83 लाख पासपोर्ट की तुलना में, वित्त वर्ष 2025-26 में यह संख्या बढ़कर 138 लाख से ज़्यादा हो गई है। यह वैश्विक स्तर पर आगे बढ़ रहे भारत की आकांक्षाओं को पूरा करने के प्रति मंत्रालय की प्रतिबद्धता का प्रमाण है।

मैं इस अवसर पर मंत्रालय तथा केंद्रीय पासपोर्ट संगठन के समर्पित अधिकारियों एवं कर्मचारियों के अथक प्रयासों एवं पासपोर्ट सेवा कार्यक्रम से जुड़े हमारे सभी सहयोगियों—डाक विभाग, पुलिस प्राधिकरण, इंडिया सिक्योरिटी प्रेस, नासिक तथा अन्य सेवा प्रदाताओं के सतत योगदान की प्रशंसा करता हूँ।

HON'BLE PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI PARTICIPATES IN BHARAT INNOVATES 2026

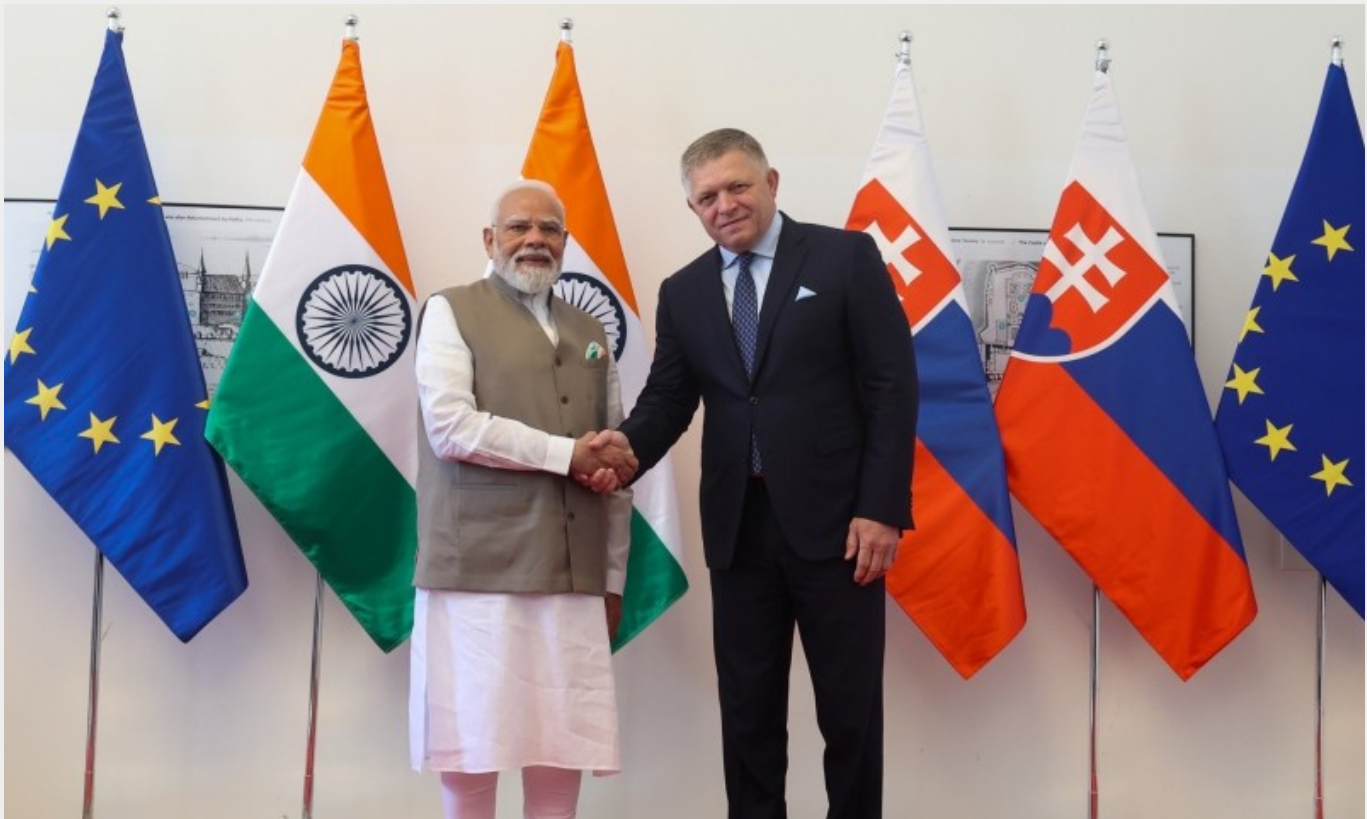


Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi and the President of France, H.E. Emmanuel Macron, jointly inaugurated "Bharat Innovates 2026" at the Palais des Expositions, Nice. Bharat Innovates, a three-day event, brought together Indian deep-tech start-ups, innovators, researchers and investors with global innovation funds and footprint. It showcased India's premier deep technology at the global stage, presenting 120 pathbreaking start-ups and over 20 Institutes of Excellence, across 13 critical technology pillars of global importance. Over 350 top investors and venture capitalists from across the world participated in the event.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Emmanuel Macron addressed the gathering. Prime Minister thanked President Emmanuel Macron for his gracious presence and noted that both India and France have been steadfast partners working to address global challenges. In this context, he highlighted Indo-French initiatives such as the International Solar Alliance, as also those in the areas of Artificial Intelligence and the promotion of stability and security in the Indo-Pacific. 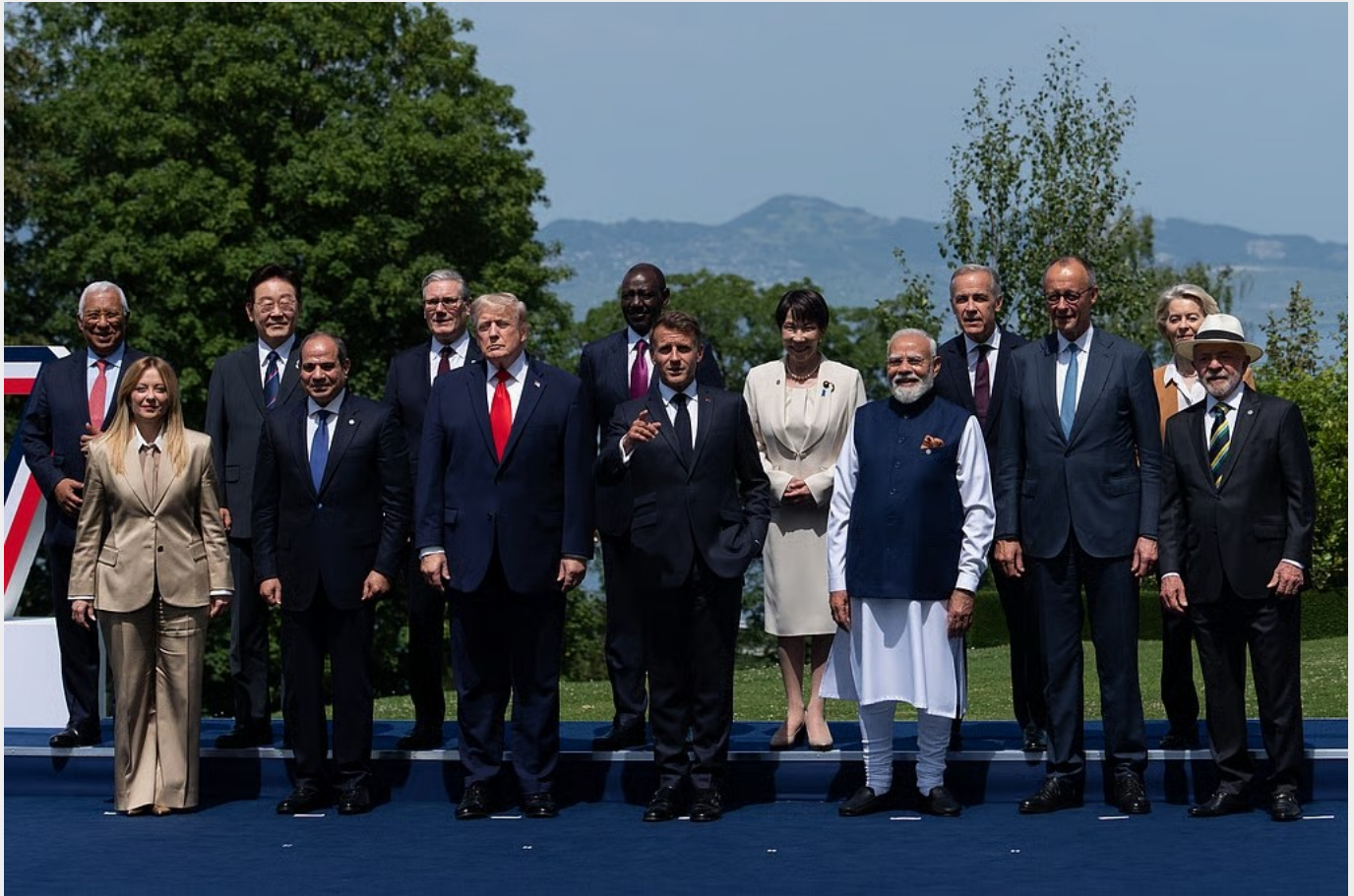

Prime Minister Modi thanked Prime Minister Fico for the solidarity and support extended by Slovakia to India in the aftermath of the terrorist attack in Pahalgam in April 2025. This underscores the strong commitment of both countries to countering terrorism, in all its forms and manifestations. PRIME MINISTER ADDRESSES THE SESSION ON “FORGING NEW PARTNERSHIPS AND REBUILDING INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY” AT G7 SUMMIT IN FRANCE



Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi addressed the Outreach Session on “Forging New Partnerships and Rebuilding International Solidarity”, at the G7 Summit in Evian, France.

In his intervention, Prime Minister underlined that, in an interconnected world, where energy, food, health, cyber, and economic security are intertwined, building international partnerships was a necessity for the progress and prosperity of humanity. He further added that, in an uncertain world, trade and technology were being misused for narrow interests, leading to a trust deficit in the international arena. Alluding to the lessons from the COVID pandemic, he called upon nations to focus on building trust and transparency in global partnerships.

Sharing India's approach to international cooperation, Prime Minister stated that India has always followed the principle of “humanity first”, and this thought continues to be at the center of its efforts, be it pursuing action under the International Solar Alliance, Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure, Global bio-fuel Alliance, Mission LiFE or Ek Ped Maa ke Naam [Plant for Mother] campaign. He further added that this inclusive approach has also led India to be the first responder when natural disasters have struck various parts of the world – be it a cyclone in Sri Lanka, earthquake in Afghanistan, floods in Mozambique or hurricane in Jamaica.

CABINET DECISIONS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE 2026



1. The Union Cabinet chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi has approved one-time budgetary support not exceeding Rs.10,000 crore for Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) to provide ATF price stabilisation support to Scheduled Indian Airlines for their domestic and international operations. The budgetary support shall be in the form of interest-free advances to OMCs through the Demands for Grants of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas.
2. The Union Cabinet chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi has approved a landmark two-year scheme aimed at reducing air pollution in the Delhi–NCR region and promoting cleaner mobility. The scheme will be funded through the National Capital Region Planning Board (NCRPB) under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) and implemented by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) and Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG).
3. The Union Cabinet passed a resolution marking June 10, 2026, as an historic milestone in the journey of Indian democracy applauding Mr. Narendra Modi for becoming the longest-serving elected Prime Minister of the country. By establishing a record of 4,399 days of continuous service as an elected PM, he has surpassed the previous record held by Mr. Jawaharlal Nehru, who served for 4,398 continuous days from 1952 to 1964.
4. The Union Cabinet chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi has approved Phase 2(A) of Ahmedabad Metro Rail Project with corridor for a length of 6.032 Km with 05 stations (04 Elevated and 01 underground). On operationalisation of Phase 2(A), Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar will have 77.63 Km of active Metro Rail Network.
